Environmental and amenities improvement

A second part of the long-term project is to help improve the diet, hygiene, sanitation and clean water supply in negotiation with the communities – thus improving their basic quality of life and long term health.

Education and Spiritual Development

The third stage is to establish a school and discipleship training centre for the local area to help improve basic literacy, numeracy and other basic skill requirements.

Comment

'For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink. I was a stranger and you invited me in, I needed clothe and you clothed me, I was sick and you looked after me, I was in prison and you came to visit me'... 'I tell you the truth what ever you did for one of the least of these brothers of mine; you did for me [*Matthew*. 25: 35, 36, 40].

This challenge has come to us through the work of our partners in areas where many children have been made orphans, due to parents dying of AIDS.
